If your advancement record is complete and all criteria are filled in satisfactorily, the registrar will be able to print a "Verified Application". The "Verified Application" will then be emailed to the unit advancement chairman or other unit designee. Upon receipt of the application by the unit, the following needs to be completed: requirement 2, references; certification by applicant; unit approval. The verified "**Eagle Scout Rank Application Form**" will then be taken to the Board of Review, along with the statement of your goals and ambitions.

My advancement chairman or designee has checked my record through "Internet Advancement" or by contacting the Council Registrar and has confirmed that my record is complete and correct and that I earned at least 21 merit badges, including 12 required badges. My tenure for the ranks of 1st Class, Star and Life meet or exceed the minimum requirements.
