## Registration

- Registration is complete when all fees are paid and payment is received.
- Registration, payment, and BSA Annual Health and Medical Record(s) must be received in the Hawkeye Area Council office by close of business on the deadline date.

## Express Check in (optional)

- Packs complete a Unit Swim Classification Test prior to camp (work with a troop to accomplish).
- Unit registration coordinator collects unit roster/swim test listing, health forms, and medications.
- At the check-in station, the coordinator will be informed of further action with the materials.

## BSA Annual Health and Medical Record for all participants

- Parent/Guardian to complete Parts A and B.
- Each youth and adult must have a separate BSA Health and Medical Record.
- Attach a photocopy of both sides of the family insurance card.
- Keep the original form. Submit a legible copy to your Pack Camping Coordinator.
- On-site camp check-in is incomplete without a Health and Medical Record for all participants.
