### Important reminders

- To help you with Cub Camp expenses, turn in a Campership Application before May 1.
- You will save money by registering on or before Tuesday, May 18.
- Reservations close about two weeks before camp.
- **BSA Medical Forms A and C** are required for everyone at camp (youth, adults, and staff), and are due with reservation and payment. Physical form B is recommended. Attach a copy of the front and back of your family insurance card.
- All prescription and non-prescription medicine for youth and adults must be stored in the medical office. The health officer must dispense the medicine. Only exceptions are medicines for immediate need, such as for asthma, heart condition, or insect stings.
- A request for Special Dietary food service is due two weeks before camp.

Pre Camp Swim Test is recommended for Cub Scouts attending either Bear or Webelos camps. This will be reviewed by camp staff during orientation.
