**The restriction on our non-fully embroidered flaps (f2) in the 1960's was that you could buy as many as you wanted to but you could not trade them with anyone outside the lodge. It was rumored that if you did, you would be kicked out of the lodge.**

**In 1970, the lodge created the blue Brotherhood flap. This flap was issued to every Brotherhood member of our lodge on a one per life basis. Records were kept by the lodge secretary to determine if you had received your Brotherhood flap or not. If you lost it or it was stolen, the lodge would not replace it.**

What is the totum or symbol of our lodge? **The Black Crescent**

What does the name Cho-Gun-Mun-A-Nock mean? **Dark slice of the evening moon**

What language does this name come from? **The language of the Nantick Indians**

What is the name of an adult Firebuilder in our current Duty System? **Tindenchin**

Who was the first member of our lodge to receive the national OA Distinguished Service Award? **Andy Zahn**
